KAGRA+ planning


- We should plan ahead (~10 years)
- The upgrade plan can be an insurance to achieve the design sensitivity
 - e.g. squeezing instead of high power laser
 - new mirrors in case present mirrors are broken
- It will also be a good chance to review current KAGRA design

- Variational readout
- Khalili cavity
- Filter cavity
- Delay-line, folded arms
- Half cryogenic
- Higher order modes
- Focus on low frequency
